Please join ASCE and LABS to learn more about the challenges of operating the 95-year old North Outfall Sewer (NOS). On July 18th, 2016, a 60-inch semi-elliptical section of the sewer collapsed on Mission Road near 6th Street. The incident produced a large sanitary sewer overflow onto the streets and into storm drains tributary to the Los Angeles River.

Javier Dennis, an Environmental Engineering Associate with the City of Los Angeles – Bureau of Sanitation (LA Sanitation), will present on the history of the NOS; details of the sewer collapse, mitigation, and repair efforts; and current assessment and rehabilitation efforts of this centennial piece of the wastewater collection system infrastructure.
