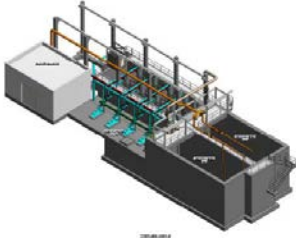




# The Los Angeles Basin Section of CWEA Dinner Meeting and Presentation December 14, 2017



## Tertiary Membrane Bioreactor for Pristine Reclaimed Water

Low turbidity recycled water with low concentrations of ammonia and suspended solids was required by an oil refinery in greater Los Angeles. To provide this water, a recycled water reclamation facility is in the process of installing a tertiary membrane bioreactor.
