Please join LABS and learn about this first-of-its-kind stormwater diversion facility in the City of Carson. The facility pairs a 4.4 million gallon (13.5 acre feet) underground tank with real-time sewer capacity monitoring and diversion to capture 27 acre feet during an 85<sup>th</sup> percentile 24-hour design storm. This reduces pollutants in the downstream Wilmington Drain and Machado Lake and meets an important compliance milestone for all of Carson's area and the County's unincorporated area in the tributary subwatershed.
